

Neck Tie Cooler

Ingredient: Polymer, a moisture holding soil amendment found at nurseries and hardware stores. (Acrylamide copolymer) On the internet you can search: Terra Sorb a brand name for a polymer.

- 1. Cut one width 5-5 1/2" wide, selvage to selvage.
- 2. Fold in half lengthwise, right sides together.
- 3. Stitch as shown, leaving approximately 4" in the center open.



- 4. Turn right side out, and you will have a tube with a center opening.
- 5. Stitch the two end sections closed., leaving approximately 10" of the tube open in the center.



- 6. Fill into the center opening, approximately 1 1/2 teaspoons of the polymer.
- 7. Top stitch the opening closed.

To use the cooler, soak in cold water for a few minutes, it will swell up and remain moist for hours.

I made a small one for my little Yorkie and used 1 teaspoon of polymer. It is not necessary to use much polymer, you will be surprised how it swells. I understand that it is washable.

This neck cooler is found in many styles, this is simply a suggestion. My quilt guild and many volunteers are making and sending these to our troops and others.
